

STUDENT CONSUMER INFORMATION

Petra College seeks to prepare each student to enter the workforce by providing the highest quality career training to all enrolled students. The following consumer information is provided to benefit current and prospective students and any other interested party. Petra College seeks to provide all available information so current and prospective students can make informed decisions.

The Higher Education Act of 1965 (HEA), as amended by the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (HEOA), includes many disclosure and reporting requirements. A disclosure requirement is information that a postsecondary education institution is required to distribute or make available to another party, such as students or employees. A reporting requirement is information submitted to the U.S. Department of Education or other agencies. Disclosure and reporting requirements sometimes overlap. For certain topics, institutions, such as Petra College, are required to make information available to students or others and to submit information to the Department of Education. In addition to federal requirements, in the 2010 session, the Louisiana Legislature passed two compliance resolutions: HCR 152 and HCR 197. This section contains all mandated compliance initiatives.
